1. **Legal Compliance:** This registration is subject to Rule 3[5][4] and the Governing Council must strictly adhere to all conditions specified in Rule 4[4].
2. **Infrastructure:** Approval is contingent upon providing adequate school premises, site area, buildings, furniture, staff, and financial stability.
3. **Restricted Expansion:** No additional sections may be opened without prior government approval.
4. **Operational Consistency:** The school must operate only at the approved location, under the authorized management, and using the registered name. No change of location is permitted.



5. **Government Orders:** The institution must follow all existing and future government orders, including the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
6. **Non-Grant-in-Aid Status:** The school is permanently unaided as per government orders. The management must submit an affidavit on ₹10 stamp paper before a Notary confirming they will not seek government grants.
7. **Staffing:** Recruitment and service conditions must comply with the Karnataka Private Educational Institutions Rules, 1999. Only trained and qualified teachers may be appointed.
8. **Curriculum:** Only textbooks and examination systems prescribed by the Department and Government shall be adopted.
9. **Attendance:** A minimum attendance of 25 students must be maintained in every authorized class.
10. **Facilities:** Security deposits must be maintained in a joint account with the Deputy Director. Furniture, library books, and playground facilities must be provided within one year, or registration may be cancelled.
11. **Health & Sanitation:** Annual medical checkups for students are mandatory. Separate toilets for boys and girls and clean drinking water must be provided.
12. **Safety:** The management must ensure building safety against fire, wind, and electrical accidents. A notice prohibiting tobacco sales within 100 yards of the school must be displayed.
13. **Recognition:** The management must apply for primary recognition within three months of starting the school. Failure to obtain recognition within the stipulated time will result in automatic cancellation of registration.

1. This registration is subject to the factors specified in Rule-3(5)(d) of the Karnataka Educational Institutions (Private Educational Institutions Control, Classification) Rules-1997.
2. As per Rules 4, 5, 6, and 8 of the Karnataka Educational Institutions (Classification, Regulation, and Prescription of Curricula, etc.) Rules 1995, as a safety measure, the school building must mandatorily have a high-quality roof and provision for proper ventilation and light. Separate toilets must be provided for boys and girls. Drinking water must be provided. Dangerous areas within the school premises must be fenced, and a compound wall must be mandatorily constructed for the safety of children. Necessary safety measures must be taken to prevent fire accidents.
3. The educational institution shall not open additional sections under any circumstances without prior permission from the Government.

As per Government Notification No. ED 369 PGC 2014 dated: 11.11.2014 and related amendment orders, the institution must maintain a prescribed security deposit in a joint account of the recognition renewal authority and the Secretary of the Governing Body to start the school.
12. The student-teacher ratio must be maintained in every permitted class as per the rules of Annexure-5 of Government Notification No: ED 52 VVD 99 dated: 02.02.2000.
- ✓ 13. Teachers with B.Ed. training must be appointed for classes 6 to 8.
14. Basic infrastructure such as furniture, teaching equipment, library, playground, and school building must be provided as per the rules of the Karnataka Education Bill.
15. School working hours and days must follow the department's rules.
- ✓ 16. After starting the school, a report of student enrollment must be submitted to this office within two months of registration or the start of the academic year. If the school is not opened or if any conditions are not followed, this order will be cancelled automatically.
17. If there is already a Kannada medium school from 1st to 7th standard, ensure that the grant of the English medium higher primary school does not affect the Kannada medium classes in any way.

The certificate obtained from the competent authority per the aforementioned fire safety circular must be renewed periodically and submitted to the concerned Deputy Director.
18. Building safety certificates must be renewed periodically by the competent authority and submitted to the concerned Deputy Director.
19. If the documents uploaded online are found to be not genuine, this order will be automatically cancelled.
20. Service security rules must be mandatorily followed in the school.
