CONDITIONS:

1. The school is registered and recognition is renewed up to the registered classes as per the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983, along with the rules framed thereunder. There is no permission to conduct additional classes or additional sections beyond these specified classes.
2. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act, 1983, and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.
3. Under the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009, 25% of seats must be reserved for children belonging to weaker sections. The government has the authority to enroll children under RTE in schools falling under the scope of RTE. Children will be enrolled in Government or Aided educational institutions if available in the neighborhood; otherwise, private schools must admit children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education until the primary stage. These children must be allowed to continue their studies without any discrimination.
4. The government will release fees for children admitted under RTE rules as explained in condition 3. Therefore, collecting any fees from these children is prohibited.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any capitation fees or voluntary donations from parents at the time of admission or thereafter in any manner.
6. The school/management shall display information regarding the fees fixed by them on the school notice board, website, and SATS as per Section 2B of the RTE Act. No fee in excess of the prescribed fee shall be collected.
7. The school/management shall admit students only within the period prescribed by the government.
8. The school/management shall not deny admission based on the following:
 - o (i) Lack of proof of age.
 - o (ii) Caste, religion, place of birth, or language.
 - o (iii) Request for admission after the extended period of admission.
9. All safety measures must be taken according to RTE Act/Rules and Karnataka Education Act/Rules. (Obtaining Fire Safety and Building Safety certificates from competent authorities and ensuring safety of children's learning as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R) .
10. The school/management shall:
 - o (i) Not hold back any child in any class or expel them from school until the completion of primary and secondary education.
 - o (ii) Not subject any child to physical or mental harassment.
 - o (iii) No child is required to pass any Board examination until the completion of primary education.
 - o (iv) Every child completing primary education shall be issued a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule 21 and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - o (v) The school must also enroll children with special needs/special children as per the provisions of RTE and Karnataka Education Acts/Rules.
 - o (vi) Appointed teachers must possess the minimum qualifications prescribed for primary and high school teachers in RTE/Karnataka Education Acts/Rules and Government Orders.



- (vii) Salaries, allowances, and service terms for teachers shall be as prescribed by the State Government. Salaries shall be paid through Bank and other modes including Provident Fund (PF) and Employee State Insurance (ESI) as per Government notifications.
 - (viii) Teachers shall perform duties prescribed under Section 24(1) of the Act and Rule 17 of RTE/Karnataka Education Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions.
11. The school shall follow the State Curriculum and State Textbooks to which it is affiliated.
 12. The school shall maintain rules and standards as specified in Section 19 of the Karnataka Education Act. Departmental staff shall be appointed as indicated in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 13. School buildings and other infrastructure shall not be used for any commercial activities, political, or non-educational activities during day or night.
 14. The school shall not be run for the profit of any individual, group, or association.
 15. The school accounts shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant, and a copy shall be submitted to the Deputy Director / Block Education Officer by the end of June every year.
 16. The school shall follow the language policy as per the Government Notification (Kannada Language Policy 2016).
 17. The management and teachers shall function according to the RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 18. The school/management must strictly follow the rules and directions of the Government and the Department.
 19. It is mandatory to update school information in SATS as per rules by the end of March every year.
 20. Violation of the above conditions will lead to the cancellation of school recognition as per rules framed under RTE Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
 21. After the completion of the school recognition process, the complete documents /information submitted by the management in the online application will be made available for public viewing on the departmental website.
 22. Violation of the above conditions will lead to the cancellation of school recognition as per rules framed under RTE Act 2009 and Karnataka Education Act 1983.
 23. Safety certificates and lease agreement documents obtained from competent authorities must be renewed within 1 month of their expiry and mandatorily uploaded to SATS.
